CHEAT SHEET

Popcorn is a crucial concession item offered at the theater, and it's important that you never let it run out or burn.



Turn on the kettle heat and kettle motor

Also turn on popper shelf heat if applicable.



Fill your popcorn scooper to the brim with seeds

Then measure and pour the appropriate amount of seasoning salt on top of the seeds.



When the machine beeps, it means the kettle is fully heated

Pour the seeds into the kettle and press the oil button. Some machines also have an oil master button that also needs to be turned on.





Wait for the popcorn to pop

This will take a few minutes.



When the popping begins to slow down, dump the kettle

This will take a few minutes. Be sure not to let the popcorn cook too long and burn!



Use the sifter to sift the popcorn

This will remove small crumbs from your popcorn.



Put the sifter and scooper back in their respective places

If you're done making popcorn for the time being, turn off the machine.
